2018 – 11,040 motor vehicle theft offenses




There were 10,575 motor vehicle theft offenses in Virginia in 2019. That's 465 fewer than reported in 2018, more than a **4 percent decrease**.




35 percent of auto thefts occurred between **June and September**.


2018 - 1,147 arrests



The number of arrests **decreased 11 percent in 2019**. Seventeen percent of all arrests in 2019 were minors under the age of 18.



53 percent of all auto thefts occurred between 6 p.m. and 3 a.m.



There were 9,432 reported victims of auto theft in 2019, a decrease of 2.3 percent from the previous year.



41 percent of auto thefts occured at a residence in 2019.



In 2019, the value of stolen motor vehicles totaled **\$120 million**, a **27.7 percent increase** from 2018, when the value of vehicles stolen was **\$94 million**.
