

## 2017 | VIRGINIA MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT ANNUAL STATISTICS

2016 - 9,575 motor vehicle theft offenses



There were 9,947 motor vehicle theft offenses in Virginia in 2017. That's 372 more than reported in 2016, almost a **4 percent increase**.



37 percent of auto thefts occurred between **June and September.** 


2016 – 997 arrests

2017 – 1,110 arrests

The number of arrests increased 11 percent in 2017.



37 percent of all auto thefts occurred between 8 p.m. and 2 a.m.



There were 9,211 reported victims of auto theft in 2017, an increase of 3.5 percent from the previous year.



More than **43 percent** of auto thefts occured at a residence.

In 2017, the average value per completed motor vehicle theft was **\$8,777**, an increase from **\$8,668** in **2016**.



In 2017, the value of stolen motor vehicles totaled **\$86 million, a 5.7 percent increase** from 2016, when the value of vehicles stolen was **\$81.4 million.**
