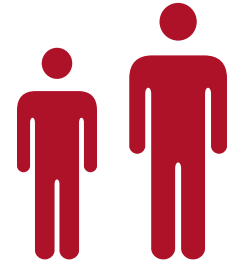
2020 – 11,209 motor vehicle theft offenses



2021 – 11,638 motor vehicle theft offenses



There were 11,638 motor vehicle theft offenses in Virginia in 2021. That's 429 more than reported in 2020, a **4 percent increase**. In 2021, 7,589 stolen vehicles were recovered by Virginia law enforcement agencies.



54% of victims of vehicle theft were between the **ages of 18 and 44**.

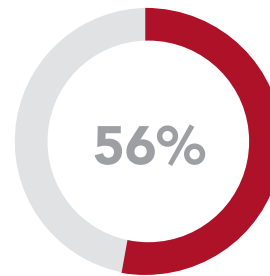
2020 - 1,068 arrests



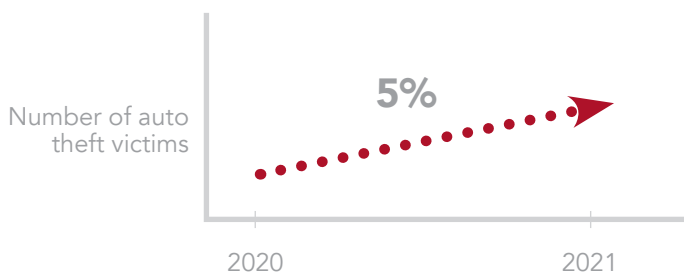
2021– 1,014 arrests



The number of arrests **decreased by 5 percent**. Twelve percent of all arrests in 2021 were minors under the age of 18.



56 percent of all auto thefts occurred between **6 p.m. and 6 a.m.**



There were 10,346 reported victims of auto theft in 2021, **an increase of 5 percent from the previous year**.



35 percent of auto thefts occurred at a residence in 2021.



In 2021, the value of stolen motor vehicles totaled **\$134 million, a 2.2 percent decrease** from 2020, when the value of vehicles stolen was **\$137 million**.
